WHEREAS, the Headrest Suicide Crisis Hotline was founded on January 4, 1971, by group of dedicated Dartmouth College students and community volunteers; and


WHEREAS, the Hotline has provided over 430,000 continuous hours of operation to residents in New Hampshire and parts of Maine and Vermont; and
